The toilet paper was especially appreciated as we have not hardstand latrines and only a 60 port-johns for a FOB of 700 people and we frequently run out of TP. The food is starting to get better every day, the other day we had steak and shrimp. Some people asked me a question about my favorite Sport team and to answer truthfully the Fairbanks Ice Dogs. They are a junior hockey team near my base in Alaska. Last year they won the national tournament, but for the teams in Illinois I root for the Bears and Blackhawks I am not really a fan of baseball or basket ball. If I have left anybody out of this e-mail who contributed to the package forgive me, as I am having a had time reading some of the letters. I have been up all night reading reports and writing orders.
